1: UH11-2005	M 33	Nodular lesion lower lip (UCH)
2: 11C2088	F 86	Tumour in cheek mucosa; CAM5.2+, S100+, EMA+, focal p63+, MIB1+ 4% (Welwyn)
3: 25569/11	M 32	Firm lesion dorsum of tongue (Aberdeen)
4: UH11-3065	F 54	Lump anterior tongue – lipoma? (UCH)
5: 10/1494	F 65	White striae and erythema left cheek mucosa and left and right lateral borders of tongue. Patient on thyroxine. Biopsy left lateral tongue (Sheffield)
6: 16051/11	M 73	Resection of lower lip for ? BCC of 20mm maximum dimension (Dublin)

#### Oral & Maxillofacial/ENT

7: 15596/10	F 60	Parotid gland; FNA contained lymphocytes and keratinous debris (Dublin)
8: 10/20793	M 14	Nine month vascular lesion nape of neck; haemangioma? (Bath)
9: 2891/11	F 43	Left upper eyelid lesion. Molluscum? Epithelial inclusion cyst? (East Grinstead)
10: 11360	M 58	Enlarged 3 cm right cervical lymph node. FNA diagnosis: lymphoma (Chelmsford)
11: M371/11	F 50	Parotid tumour (Manchester)
12: UH10-13004	M 12	Persistent right submandibular lymphadenopathy (UCH)

#### ENT

13: PR10949/11	M 87	Five month history of right parotid lump; no facial weakness (Newcastle)
14: 452/09	M 41	Parotid tumour 20 years ago, diagnosis? Now hard parotid swelling (East Grinstead)
15: 21851	M 59	Recurrent nasal tumour; previous nasal melanoma (Oxford)
16: 3659/10	M 60	Incidental epiglottic lesion. Intubation granuloma? Epiglottic cyst? Non-smoker, non drinker. Hepatitis C liver disease/liver transplant (KCL)
17: 2695/10	F 46	Multinodular goitre. Thy 2 on FNA (KCL)
18: L11/09329	F 24	Total thyroidectomy for thyrotoxicosis; did not respond to high dose carbimazole, could not be treated with radioiodine because she wanted more children (Stoke)
